It's taking more than 3 minutes longer to get from 911 call to your door than five years ago.

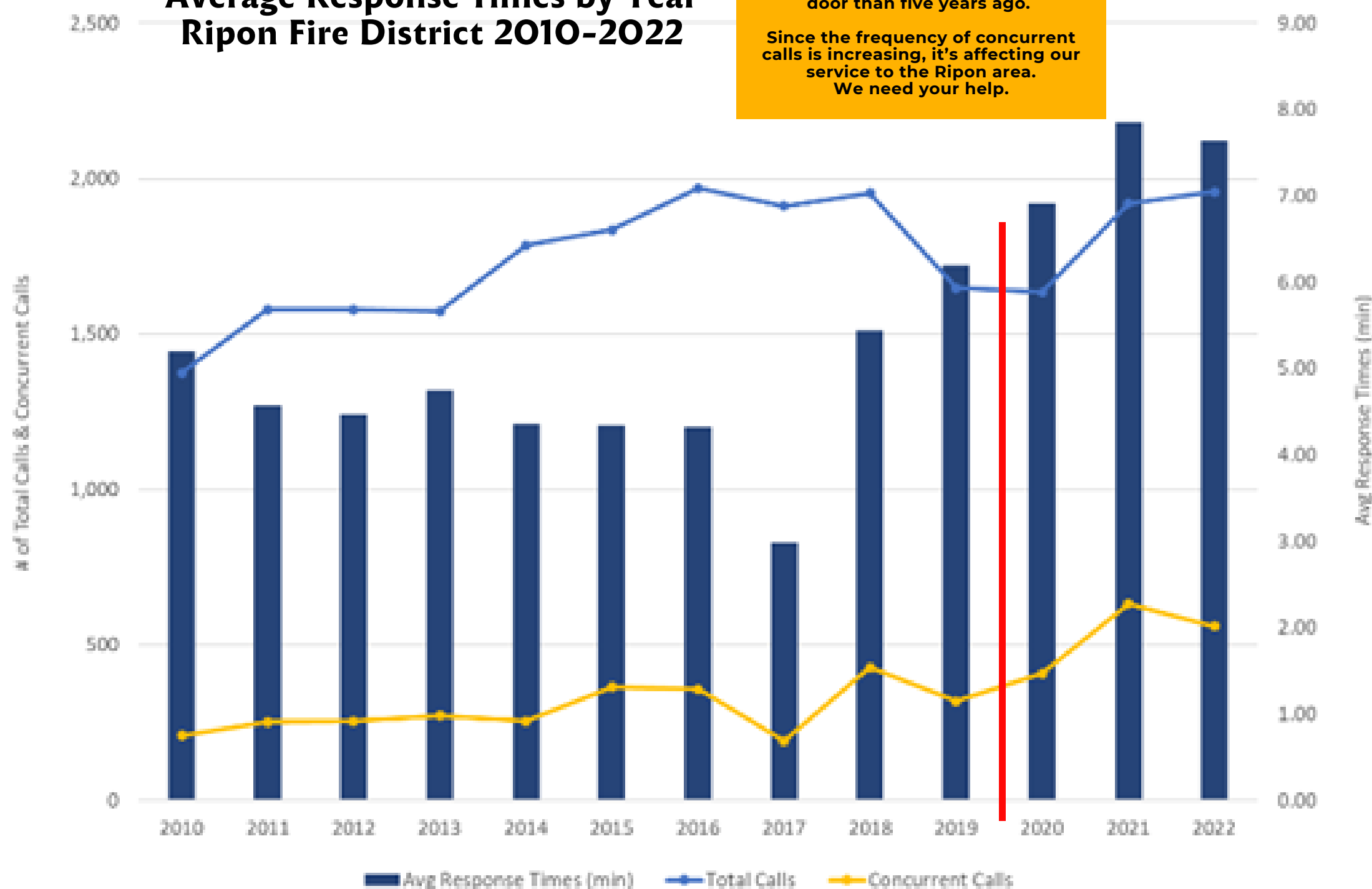
Since the frequency of concurrent calls is increasing, it's affecting our service to the Ripon area. We need your help.
